SAN ANTONIO 110 9/11 Memorial Climb Registration Rules and Information

- Registration will open on July 1st and will close approximately 3 weeks prior to event or when reached maximum for event, whichever occurs first. San Antonio 110 has the right to close registration earlier or extend as they see necessary.
- Must be at least 15 years of age at time of registration. If under the age of 18 a legal guardian must be present to sign waivers or must be legally an adult by state emancipation law. All first responders carrying one of the fallen tags must be at least 18 years of age and certified in their profession.
- Although there is no charge to register we ask in lieu that participants donate via online or event day to our event and beneficiary. Many of these 110 floor climbs nationwide ask for \$1 per floor.
 SA110 simply requires a small donation at registration. Donations may additionally be made online or event day. These funds pay for events expenses with proceeds donated to designated beneficiary.
- Registering online does not guarantee a photo and accountability tag for a fallen firefighter for
 participant to carry. It DOES however place each participant on the Precedence List for a photo and
 tag. Precedence will be as follows: Firefighters, Law Enforcement, Military and current First
 Responder EMTs, Civilian/Public. (Firefighters will have precedence for the 343 firefighter tags, Law
 Enforcement Officers will have precedence for the 70 LEO tags, and EMS will have first precedence
 for the EMS tags.) Must be at least 18 years of age to qualify for Precedence List. Our new
 registration separates these tags (and participant slots) by profession. All others will be placed on
 standby by precedence list priorities. Be prepared to show proof of appropriate profession ID at
 check in. Anyone who presents a fraudulent claim to one of these professions will be removed from
 the event. Please be aware it is also illegal. Please respect what we are doing.
- Tags will be given out first to pre-registered participants at check-in on event day. ALL participants who pre-register online will be given first opportunity for these tags. After check-in for all participants is complete if there are remaining tags left they will be handed out to non-preregistered participants accordingly.
- ALL participants MUST check-in during designated times provided in the Event Schedule. Failure to do so forfeits your eligibility for a tag and your participation in the event.
- All climbers should consult their physician and be engaged in an adequate physical conditioning program prior to the event.
- ALL participants must agree to these Registration Rules, Event Rules, and all necessary waivers to participate. Please print and completely read all required information.
- By registering for this event you are agreeing that you have read, understand, and agree to the Registration Rules, Event Schedule, Event Rules, and Liability waivers.
