Our event is 100% volunteer run and is funded solely by the generosity of our community and participants.

All donations received go first and foremost to our only true cause: To hold a tribute for our fallen brethren of 9/11. Our primary goal, as all "110 climbs", is to honor and pay respect to the brave 343 firefighters who perished at ground zero. We do this by carrying each of their photos and names on a tribute tag up the stairs of the Tower Of The Americas, twice in fact, by those of their respected brethren, to honor and complete the 110 floor climb they did not get to. In addition, our event pays tribute for the 70 fallen Law Enforcement Offers and 9 EMS personnel as well. We do this under a code of One Brotherhood.

Our goal is to provide a memorial event for our firefighters and other first responders, at the lowest possible expense to them, to honor their fallen brothers and sisters. We also invite our civilian community to join us in doing so. All donations and funds go directly towards the event expenses to provide this and to create as meaningful and honorable of a memorial as possible for our fallen heroes. Should there be remaining proceeds, they are used to help towards our future sustainability as well as given to multiple causes and to support needs in our community throughout the year. We have gifted over \$100k in donations since our establishment in 2013.

So as to allow organizations and businesses of all sizes the opportunity to be a part of the San Antonio 110 9/11 Memorial Climb and this great cause we have three levels of sponsorship available. Our Bronze level offers exposure on our website, special thanks posted on our social media, and other avenues as they arise. Silver level sponsorship also includes a logo on our two large event day banners displayed on the event grounds. Our Gold level sponsorship also includes logo placement on our annual T-shirts. We also limit the number of spots available for each level of sponsorship. In turn, this also increases the magnitude in which our generous sponsors stand out at our SA110.

SAN ANTONIO 110 9/11 Memorial Climb Event Rules

The objectives of the San Antonio 110 9/11 Memorial Climb are to provide: first and foremost, a solemn and reverent memorial event to honor the 343 fallen firefighters and honor our fallen heroes of 9/11; a memorial event that is free from commercial and political influence; an event that occurs annually on or near the September 11th anniversary date; an opportunity for local individuals, businesses and organizations to support local firefighters and police officers and their families; an opportunity for the public to witness local heroes commitment to duty and ability to perform; and, motivation for firefighters and police officers to be physically prepared for the rigors of the profession. **Those who fail to abide by these rules may forfeit their right to participate in this and future San Antonio 110 9/11 Memorial Climb events.**

VOLUNTEERS, PARTICIPANTS, GUESTS AND PRESENT SPONSORS SHALL

- -Immediately advise an event coordinator if unable to attend
- -Come appropriately attired (t-shirt or tank top and jeans or shorts, both of appropriate length)
- -Arrive on time and immediately check-in
- -Read, agree to, and sign appropriate liability waiver(s)
- -Be attentive for and respectful of the symbolic elements of the event
- -Follow the direction of any and all Event Coordinators and Directors
- -Immediately notify your group leader and/or EMS personnel if you or someone you see needs medical assistance
- -Abide by all safety and security measures enforced by local law enforcement and SA110 personnel

SPECIFICALLY, VOLUNTEERS SHALL

- -Arrive early at requested times, on time
- -Ensure assignments are understood and completed, asking for help if it is needed
- -Seek opportunities to serve, and attempt to remain focused within their work assignments
- -Assist with event set up and demobilization before leaving unless previously agreed otherwise

SPECIFICALLY, PARTICIPANTS SHALL

- -Ensure they have been physically cleared by a medical professional as necessary for their participation in this event
- -Come prepared hydrated and physically capable
- -Check in during posted registration times, report to staging, and be ready to climb prior to opening ceremony
- -Strictly comply with any EMS personnel recommendations should the need arise

PARTICIPANTS SHALL NOT

- -Be guaranteed their spot if they have not completed check-in during posted registration times on the day of the event
- -"Race to the top" this climb is NOT a race and it isn't about a personal or group best. Racing will not be tolerated
- -Bring or wear dirty or contaminated bunker gear / turnouts (defined as gear that is heavily soiled and poses a cross contamination hazard or has been contaminated with biohazards)
- -Carry any hand held equipment / tools with them during the climb unless authorized by appropriate directors of event
- -During the climb discard their equipment. Should the need arise, equipment will be given to a volunteer for safe storage or removal from stairwell

PARTICIPANTS, VOLUNTEERS, SPONSORS, AND GUESTS SHALL NOT

-Conduct themselves in a manner that reflects negatively upon the fire or police service or our solemn tribute.
-Sell, distribute or advertise any interest or product, commercial, political or otherwise without prior approval from committee nor shall they remove any items from the event without the expressed written consent of the planning committee.
